New State-wide School Improvement Planning Process

This term all schools across the state will be working on the new state-wide School Improvement Planning process. By the end of this term every school is expected to have completed steps 1, 2 and 3 of the Improvement Planning work. The Governing Council Chairperson, Leanne Draper will also sign off on the plan.

During this process we will revisit our vision, and identify 3 improvement goals based on our school's student learner achievement data. Steps 1, 2 and 3 will be published on each school's website by the end of year.

In step 1, we look at our evidence of student learning and identify our goals for improvement (maximum of 3) based on the analysis of the data. We also identify incremental targets for improvement for the next 3 years. In step 2, we consider how improvements in teaching will help to achieve our improvement goals and we will identify areas of practice we will focus on improving to reach our **goals. We will identify our 'challenge of practice' for each goal in this step.**

In step 3, we identify actions we should take to improve our practice and reach our goals.

At Peterborough High we have already engaged in considerable professional learning over the past 2 years through the LDAM (Assessment and Moderation) strategy and the Visible Learning program across the Flinders Partnership to inform actions we can take to improve practice and reach our goals. On Monday this week, teachers and leaders in the Flinders Partnership engaged in the Visible Learning program at Booleroo Centre. On Tuesday next week, we have an early closure to enable teachers and leaders to travel to Orroroo to continue their collaborative work across sites in assessment and moderation.

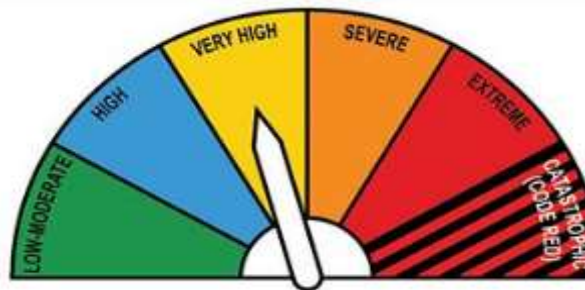
Peterborough High School Bushfire Action Plan
